 - Provide those students an opportunity to earn a living wage that helps supplement their post-secondary education funding;
 - Provide non-profit organizations serving Galveston Island an opportunity to undertake special projects and/or ongoing programs they might otherwise be unable to complete;
 - Allow those organizations to pass on the values of community service to young people who may return to Galveston post-college and become engaged, productive citizens.

2. Criteria for Evaluation of Grant Applications:

- Align to at least one of the four program goals listed above;
- Demonstrate the organization's ability to supervise/mentor intern(s);
- Clearly identify work to be completed by intern and why it is important to the organization;
- Provide a detailed program budget;
- Please review the Grant Application Overview for document requirements.

3. General Information

- Maximum Request: \$7,500 per organization;
- The salary provided to the Intern should be budgeted in the \$15 to \$20 per hour range;
- Application for funding for the Internship Program does not preclude applying for other grants from the Endowment in 2024;
- The non-profit organization is responsible for recruiting, hiring, training, supervising and mentoring its own intern;
- The non-profit organization is responsible for submitting a final grant report due within one year of receipt of the grant.
