

**Mary Moody Northen Endowment
Galveston Community Impact (GCI) Grant Application Guidelines**

Please review the goals and criteria of the Galveston Community Impact program below in order to comply with all of the parameters. A limited number of grants will be awarded.

1. Goals:

- Enable the organization to purchase equipment/vehicles/real estate/supplies essential to the delivery of services and/or accomplishment of its mission;
- Enable the organization to provide services at the core of its mission to the population it has been established to serve;
- Leverage funds that otherwise would not be available to the organization;
- Encourage partnerships with other entities to serve shared clients;
- Respond to an urgent and unexpected situation that impacts the organization’s ability to operate. Requests that are clearly urgent or emergencies can be considered outside the regular grant cycle. Please contact the Endowment’s Executive Director grant timetables.

2. Criteria for Evaluation of Grant Applications:

- Align to at least one of the five program goals listed above;
- Demonstrate the organization’s ability to serve its target population;
- Identify clearly the work to be completed and why it is important to the organization;
- Provide a detailed program budget;
- Agree to provide a short outcomes report within one year of the grant award. No further funding request will be considered until reports are on file in the Endowment office.

3. General Information

Maximum Request: \$20,000 per organization. Please be mindful that the Endowment welcomes requests for smaller amounts. An organization is limited to one GCI grant per year.

- Application for Galveston Community Impact program does not preclude applying for other types of grants from the Endowment in 2023.
- The non-profit organization is responsible for recruiting, hiring, training, and supervising staff, contractors, and vendors hired through grant funds.
- The non-profit organization is responsible for submitting a final grant report due within one year of receipt of the grant.
